Our Bear Cub Scholars Program is committed to improving the retention and success rate of foster youth in college.

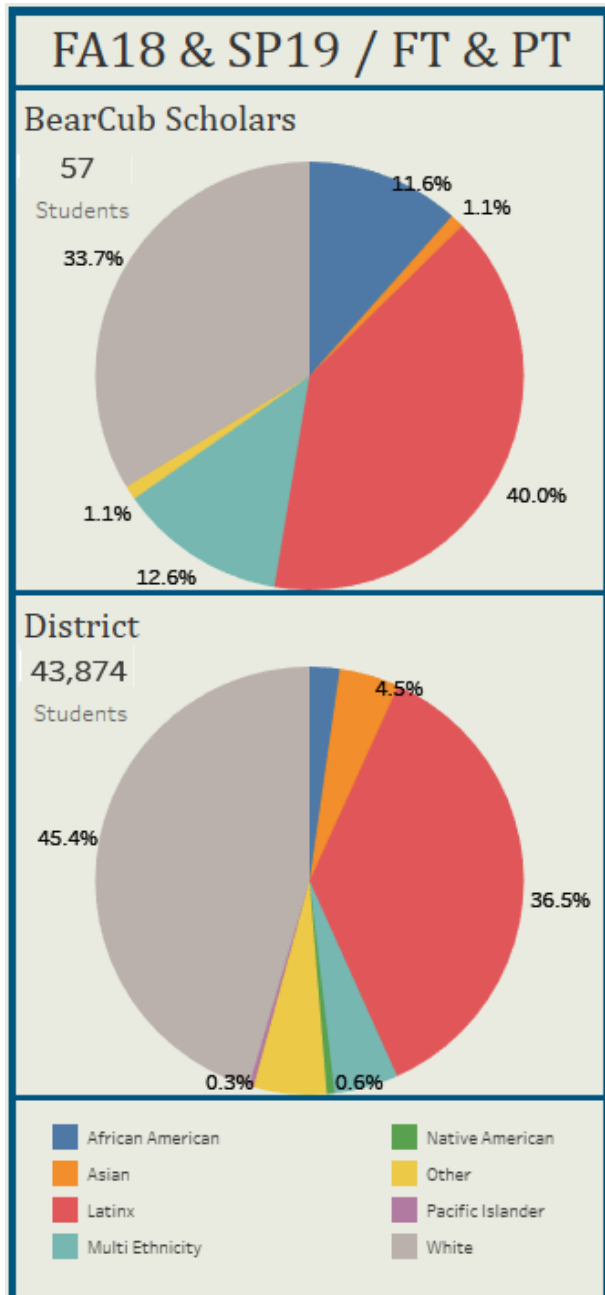
Please describe the specific activities supported by SEA funds.

The SEA funds are used to provide former foster youth with book vouchers, supply vouchers, gas cards and food vouchers and immediate temporary housing assistance. We have been able to assist students with additional supplies needed for specialized programs; scrubs for the Nursing program, art supplies some Art majors. Funding is also utilized to provide a summer bridge program for incoming students who have been in the foster care system as well as outreach to this population through collaboration with county programs and school systems. A portion is also used to support 25% of the salary of one staff member.

Share any highlights or achievements your group had during the year – refer to the following data if applicable.

In the Fall semester we have a ceremony for students who received a 3.0 GPA or higher to honor their success and commitment to their education. In the Fall 19 celebration, we had 23 who were eligible for the Honor Roll; out of those 23, 6 students received the exceptional honor of getting a 4.0!
